## Notes on compulsory schooling in the state of Bremen

Dear parents, dear legal guardians,

all children who attend school in Bremerhaven are subject to school law according to § 55 Bremen School Act.

A permit for the early start of the holiday or to extend the holidays is generally not granted. <u>This regulation applies to all school holidays in the school year 2023/2024.</u> It also applies to the summer vacation 2023.

**Please also note:** <u>Absence</u> due to illness on school days in <u>direct connection with the school</u> <u>holidays</u> must generally be excused. This already applies from a school day before or after the school holidays. <u>Excuses written</u> by the parents or the legal guardians are <u>not accepted</u> for these periods. It must be proven that there was no holiday extension.

If your children stay away from school, they commit an administrative offence according to § 65 Bremen School Act.

This administrative offence is punished with a fine. The fine is set depending on the facts and staggered according to the extent of the absenteeism. It is at least based on the child benefit rate of  $\in$  250.00.
